International Plushie Status

IPS

Generally valid for any type of stuffed animal community

- 1. Plushies First The dignity of the plushie is inviolable!
- 2. There should never be fewer than two plushies in a shared apartment, because company is important!

Plushies kept alone need extra cuddles, because they have no plushy cuddle partners.

- A plushie needs daily cuddles and attention.
 If attention cannot be guaranteed over several days, compensation should be provided in the form of biscuits or similar delicious treats.
- 4. Every plushie basically has the authority to make decisions about their plush. Everyone has the right to freely develop their plushiness, as long as they do not violate the rights of others.
- Every plushie has the right to freedom from violence and physical integrity.
 These rights may only be infringed on in the event of an emergency involving a plushie defect.
- 6. An adopted plushie may only be released for adoption by its owner in the most extreme emergency! Ideally, the connection lasts forever.
- 7. Plushies may not be sold or kept in cages.
- 8. Plushies have a right to financial autonomy; to justify and maintain this, each plushie must be given access to a credit card belonging to the person who gave them the cookies.
- 9. Anyone who puts a plushie in a helpless situation or abandons it in a helpless situation, even though they are obliged to help and care for it, the plushie then has the free choice of whether to stay with the person or to be adopted by another person. A plushie is only considered helpless when it is no longer able to protect itself from life-threatening or serious physical danger or to avert such danger.
- 10. The person must create a place for their plushie to retreat to. Small apartments in closets have proven to be effective.
- 11. Plushies should only be washed very rarely, in unavoidable exceptional cases!

- 12. Plushies should only be put in the washing machine in extreme and absolute emergencies!
- 13. Every plushie should be given support with the plushie's care to maintain its fluffiness!
- 14. Plushies should only do sport occasionally, otherwise the plushie will develop knots. However, they should be allowed to exercise in a sport of their choice!
- 15. Plushies should be allowed to go on regular trips to the ice cream parlor, the zoo, museums, the seaside or other trips, depending on the plushie's taste, interests and mood.

The plushie is automatically responsible for the tour. If this is not the case, this automatically applies. Because who knows better when you need a fluffy, cocoa and biscuit break than a plushie?

- 16. Plushies take precedence over humans when it comes to eating.

 If there is not enough food for the human and the plushie, the human gives the food, preferably one containing biscuitamine, to the plushie.
- 17. Warm pudding must be served every day!

 Alternatively, equally delicious treats containing biscuitamine can be served as an exception.
- 18. The plushies themselves determine the hierarchy in the plushie pack.
- 19. Don't forget to jump!
- 20. In places where you are not allowed to jump, you have to dance!
- 21. If the human is late or otherwise does not have time for their plushies, they are obliged to bring two different snacks (pay attention to the biscuitamine content)
- 22. Plushies have a right to participate in their humans' lives. For this purpose, they can accompany their humans everywhere.
- 23. Plushies must never be transported in dark bags, boxes, etc. without a sufficient supply of biscuitamine!
- 24. When travelling, plushies should always be transported in hand luggage or in specially designed travel luggage. Furthermore, a sufficient, adequate supply of biscuits must be ensured when travelling.
- 25. Plushies must be given access to a cell phone and the internet in order to maintain contact with friends of plushies!
- 26. The person giving the biscuits must do paperwork as the plushie's secretary.

- 27. The mobility of the plushie must be ensured.

 Ideally by means of vehicles, aircraft or swimming gear in an appropriate size purchased especially for the plushie.
- 28. Plushies are not obliged to work.
- 29. Plushies are entitled to a free health check once a year.
- 30. Plushies must be allowed to meet friends.
- 31. Plushies must be equipped with a helmet and other safety clothing or rescue harnesses when taken on two-wheelers or during similarly dangerous activities!

- 33. Plushies have the right to freedom of expression in image, sound and writing. Examples of this are Twitter, Mastodon, Instagram and Plushy Living.
- 34. If a plushie is travelling to a friend, nationally or internationally, the shortest and quickest route must always be ensured in advance.

 In addition, it is always important to ensure that there are enough travel provisions, adapted to the length of the trip, as well as comfortable beds or pillows and sufficient lighting.
- 35. This is the world of plushies, people only live in it.
- 36. Requests from plushies must be carried out immediately, i.e. without culpable hesitation and without further communication.
- 37. Plushies are free to choose their place of residence. Ideally, of course, in the immediate vicinity of their cuddly person.
- 38. The person who gave the cookie to someone must post or receive mail from a plushie to prevent injury or loss of the plushie, e.g. if it falls into a mailbox.
